Clients, friends, and horse enthusiasts,

We are gearing up for our second annual 2010 Karen Scholl Horsemanship for Women Clinic which will be held July 30th- 1st and August 6th- 8th. The beginners class will be held the first weekend and the advanced the second.

I have had a lot of questions of what the clinic entails so here is a brief break down of both. The beginner class is mostly ground work, learning to gain confidence and teaching you to gain your leadership role with your horse from a safe place. These techniques are called "Riding from the Ground". You work on perfecting your riding ability and communication with your horse by practicing all the things you do in the saddle but from the ground. The advanced class will be much the same but taking all these things and putting them into action in the saddle. Karen also takes time during lunch and after the clinic to go over specific problems, using the right tack, and any questions that you have. She is always happy to take time with each and every person and their horse.

We are requiring a \$100.00 signing deposit, to hold your spot. April 1st the 2nd payment of \$325.00 will be due and then final payment of the remaining \$325.00 July 1st.

Pricing

Beginner clinic: \$750.00 for three days 9am to 4pm(Fri-Sat-Sun). This includes breakfast, lunch, drinks and three days board for your horse with the facility.

Advanced clinic: \$750.00 for three days 9am to 4pm(Fri-Sat-Sun). This includes breakfast, lunch, drinks and three days board for your horse with the facility.

We are also offering a discounted rate if you are interested in taking both clinics of \$1400.00

Auditor: \$35.00 each day, this will also include breakfast, lunch and drinks. Seating will be provided but feel free to bring your own chair if you would like.

Notes:

- *We are in an outdoor setting so please be prepared for all weather.
- *Indoor bathrooms will be open for public use.
- *No studs allowed gelding and mares only.
- *Current vaccinations required.
- *No dogs.
